



Travel Grant Application to Attend the 2022 SACSCOC Annual Meeting

Atlanta, GA | December 3–6, 2022

SACSCOC awards a limited number of travel grants to outstanding students who are interested in learning about accreditation practices in the Southern states. Students who are pursuing a graduate degree in higher education or a related field at an institution accredited by SACSCOC are eligible to apply. The review process is competitive. Incomplete applications will not be considered. Materials must be received no later than October 3, 2022. All applications will be acknowledged upon receipt, and individuals will be notified of our decision no later than October 10, 2022. Typically, only one grant will be awarded per institution. Award recipients will be reimbursed for direct expenses after the conference.

The conference registration fee will be waived; however, you will be responsible for covering the cost of any pre-conference workshops you choose to attend.
